

RoHS DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

SUBJECT: RESTRICTION OF USE OF DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES INDICATED IN THE DIRECTIVES 2011/65/EU with the amendment (EU) 2015/863

I, the signed hereunder, declare that all PVC cable types distributed by **Firstflex**, comply with the limits set by RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU with amendment (EU) 2015/863 "Restriction on the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)".

The substances banned under RoHS are lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd), hexavalent chromium (CrVI), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), and four different phthalates (DEHP, BBP, BBP, DIBP).

Our manufacturers - raw materials suppliers have stated that the materials that we use for the manufacturing of all our cable series conform to the requirements of the 2011/65/EU with amendment (EU) 2015/863 "four additional restricted substances" (phthalates) "Restriction on the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)". Their raw materials do not exceed the mentioned limits of contaminants content.
